Bonnie McCay is Board of Governors Distinguished Service Professor at Rutgers University, New Brunswick, where she chairs the Department of Human Ecology. Her graduate training was in anthropology at Columbia University (PhD 1976), and her research and teaching have focused on challenges and policies for managing marine resources, particularly fisheries. She has done field research in Newfoundland and Nova Scotia, Canada, in New Jersey, and in Baja California, Mexico, with funding from the National Science Foundation, the New Jersey Sea Grant College Program, and the New Jersey Agricultural Experiment Station. Her books include "The Question of the Commons," "Oyster Wars and the Public Trust," and "Enclosing the Commons." She currently serves on the Science Advisory Committees for the California Current Ecosystem-Based Management Initiative and the NY Ocean and Great Lakes Ecosystem Conservation Council and heads the Resource Policy Committee of the American Fisheries Society.
